Call 811 Before You Dig Kids' Art Contest

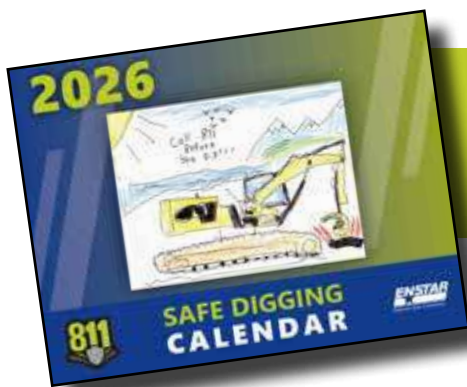
DEADLINE: MAY 1st

ENSTAR's "Call 811 Before You Dig" Kids' Art Contest will be open for submissions from April 1st – May 1st!

Before any outdoor project that calls for "disturbing the ground," which can include building a deck, removing a tree, or planting a garden, your first step is a call to the Alaska Digline by dialing 811. This free service dispatches area utilities to your project area to locate and mark underground utilities. Hitting a natural gas line threatens the safety of you, your family, and your neighbors. It can also cost more than \$1,000 to repair and cause project delays.

Help us spread the word by encouraging elementary students* in your family or community to participate in this year's contest by drawing a picture that shows why calling 811 before you dig is so important.



Selected winners will get to "dig in" to an ice cream sundae during a class party and will be featured in ENSTAR's June bill insert sent out to over 155,000 customers! Plus, your artwork could be included in ENSTAR's 2027 Safe Digging Calendar.
